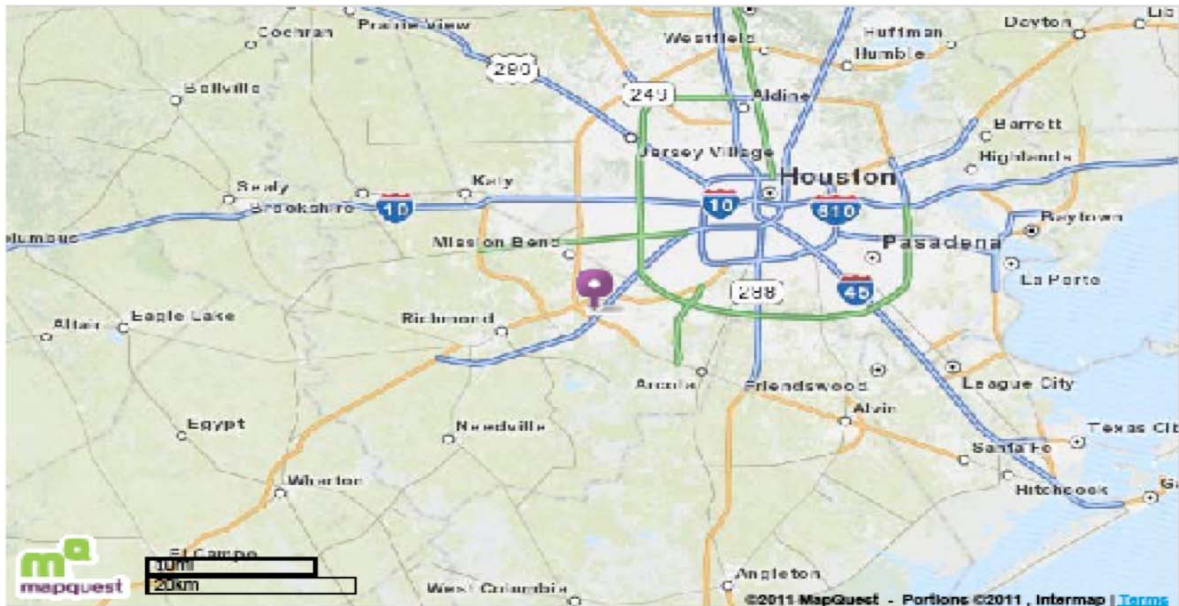

**DRIVING INSTRUCTIONS TO SUGAR LAND TOWN SQUARE**

Roughly speaking, the SLTS is located at Interstate 59 South and Hwy. 6. As you come outbound on US 59, exit Hwy. 6, make a left under the freeway, and staying in the right-hand lane. If you are driving your Jaguar, make your first right onto CITY WALK DRIVE. This will take you to the Marriott and show site. (Please refer to enclosed map).

If you are driving a trailer, go down one more street to the stop light (signs read "City Hall"), and make a right onto N. TOWN CENTER. You will see the reserved parking space for trailers one block down on the right, adjacent to the backside of City Hall where the registration RV will be. Hopefully we'll have some signs up and even a volunteer to help guide you.
