The Jaguar Club of Houston is pleased to sponsor the 2008 Spring Fling. We are excited to welcome you to historic Round Top home of the second largest antique show in Texas! We have a fun filled, action packed agenda set in the relaxing atmosphere of tiny Round Top, home of some 80 folks. The town was founded in 1870, and was named by the stagecoach drivers who used “the house with the round top” as an early stagecoach mileage designation.

You will need to come early to take in all of the attractions in Fayette County. Check out the Round Top Chamber of Commerce web site at info@roundtop.org, or “Google round top” for all of the local attractions.

You can also download maps of how to get to Round Top. The town is located 8 miles south of Hwy 290 on Hwy. 237 (12 miles west of Brenham), and running 9 miles north out of LaGrange on 237. 237 connects with 159 out of LaGrange. It’s about 2 hours out of Houston, and 90 minutes out of Austin.

The home base for the weekend activities will be at Briarfield B&B located on FM 954 in Warrenton just 3.5 miles south of Round Top on 237. Where FM 954 and 237 junction you will see the famous Sterling McCall Cadillac Museum. Coming south out of Round Top on 237, turn left on FM 954 to Briarfield B&B. The phone number for Briarfield is 979-249-3973.

We will kick off the weekend Friday evening with a reception at Briarfield hosted by JCOH from 5:00 until 7:00 P.M. If you would like to come out earlier and kick off your shoes and rock away the afternoon listening to Mockingbirds, please do so. Please bring your favorite beverage to sip on prior to the reception.

On the website you will see a listing of all of the restaurants in Round Top for dinner Friday evening, breakfast and lunch Saturday, and meals on Sunday. We will all eat together Saturday evening after the JCNA sanctioned rally at Henkel Square Museum Village across the street from the court house. Catered by the Back Door Café, we will be enjoying bar-b-que brisket, sausage, and chicken, stuffed baked potato salad, baked beans, coleslaw, homemade bread, and topped off with home baked peach cobbler with iced tea and water.
